GASOLINE QUALITY

I was perusing some auto service information recently when I ran across the term "Top Tier" gasoline. Digging around on the internet I found this little article and a list of gasolines that qualify. So here it is, including the brand names (at bottom) of the Top Tier gasolines as of July 2012.

What is TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline?

TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline is a new class of gasoline with enhanced detergency. It meets new, voluntary deposit control standards developed by six automotive companies that exceed the detergent requirements imposed by the EPA.

Where Can TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline Be Purchased?

The TOP TIER program began on May 3, 2004 and many fuel marketers have joined the program and have introduced TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline. This is a voluntary program and not all fuel marketers will offer this product. Once fuel marketers make public announcements, they will appear on a list of brands that meet the TOP TIER standards.

Who developed TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline standards?

TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline standards were developed by six automotive companies: Audi, BMW, General Motors, Honda, Toyota and Volkswagen.

Why was TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline developed?

TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline was developed to increase the level of detergent additive in gasoline. The EPA requires that all gasoline sold in the U.S. contain a detergent additive. However, the requirement is minimal and in many cases, is not sufficient to keep engines clean. In order to meet TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline standards, a higher level of detergent is needed than what is required by the EPA. Also, TOP TIER was developed to give fuel marketers the opportunity to differentiate their product.

Why did the six automotive companies join together to develop TOP TIER?

All six corporations recognized the benefits to both the vehicle and the consumer. Also, joining together emphasized that low detergency is an issue of concern to several automotive companies.

What are the benefits of TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline?

TOP TIER Detergent Gasoline will help keep engines cleaner than gasoline containing the "Lowest Additive Concentration" set by the EPA. MAGICAL MYSTERY MACHINES 2013 VW FUNFEST

Mid America Motorworks is holding its 15th annual Air-Cooled VW Magical Mystery **Funfest May** 31-June 2 at its corporate campus in Effingham, III. The event usually brings more than 8,000 enthusiasts and owners from across the world to celebrate old VWs.



This year, the special guest is two-time Bonneville Salt Flats world-record-holder Bill Hatfield. Hatfield and his 1999 Mexican Beetle, known as the Salt Flats Flyer, will stop in. He owns the record for the DSS36 (dual-carbs class, 36 hp) with a pass of 114.909 mph. He will return to the Flats this September.

Artistically painted VWs will get special treatment at the Magical Mystery Funfest. They'll enjoy their own parking spaces reserved for specialty cars.

As always, expert seminars, special displays, scavenger hunts and swap meets will be part of the party. Those events go along with a Magical Mystery road tour and Saturday night entertainment.

It wouldn't be a car show without just a little bit of judging. The Celebrity Choice award is voted on Friday, Saturday and Sunday for standout VWs from the weekend.
