Among the "one of a kind" trophywinners was Bill Deneff's Devin Roadster that he brought from Cypress, CA, Steve Young's Diva Roadster (from Lopez Island, WA) and Al Ferguson's Blast. (a one-off roadster with a turbo 2.0 liter Subaru mid-engine power plant)

Also new to this year's show was Doug Wallace's recently completed '57 T-Bird replica and James & Wendy Wagner's (just out of the paint shop) Fiero based ZR-2. They both took home a trophy.

Gil Somerhalder's 1950 Ford "Easy-Rod", built on a 1995 T-bird shell had lots of spectators wondering and scratching their heads. Jim & Kathleen Standiford brought their Tri-Magnum and the Jackrabbit giving more spectators some questions to ponder.

I suppose the most electrifying moment

was on Sunday when a pair of GT-40s owned by Bob Silva and Alank DeClue came from Oakley to give Farhad Faili's GT-40 some added competition. They said they found our "Who's Coming" section on our website and decided to increase the GT-40 population. Their cars were beautiful and quickly attracted a crowd of lookers, but Farhad Faili took the trophy.

Bill Foster returned this year with his Firewoody surf board transporter but Dane Slack got the top "Special Interest" trophy with his Suzuki powered Ford Coupe replica. Tony Moniz took 2nd in Special Interest with his Shay Model A.

The Cobra class was topped by Russ Thompson's Daytona Coupe and he also took the "Best of Show" trophy. Ed Robison's FFR Cobra took 2nd and Kie linuma took 3rd.

The Sports A class gave top honors to Farhad Faili's GT-40 with Steve Young's Diva Roadster taking 2nd and Al Bohr's Fino 3rd.

Sports B class was led by Bill Deneff's Devin with Dale Fieber's Speedster in 2nd and Doug Wallace's T-Bird 3rd.

The Classic C class was dominated by Steve Bales M-B 500K with Bill Navratil's Gatsby and the Chuck Maddux M-B 500K taking 2nd & 3rd. The Classic D class was led by Pat & Anita Cooley's Bugatti with Hans Kiel's Jaguar SS-100 and Alex Penalosa's M-B SSK taking 2nd and 3rd.

The "Manufacturer" trophy went to Cutting Edge Replicas Cobra display. They are located in Manteca, CA.

Another new feature of this year's show was the inclusion of a display by Dreamy Pedal Cars. Joe Morales came from Newman, CA with an impressive display of pedal cars and gas pumps to match. His display seemed to be quite busy.

I was pleased to see a good response some of our newest members. Chris Ward, of Lodi, built and entered his Midstates Cobra. I also had a chance to meet and greet Rick & Jeani Delany of Valley Springs, whose Gatsby is still under construction. # PENDING LEGISLATION REPORT BY ACCC

**<u>AB 386</u>**- Sally Lieber, D-San Jose - Air Pollution Inspection and Maintenance.

Existing law establishes a motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program (smog check). The Department of Consumer Affairs administers this law. The duty of enforcing and administering the program is vested in the Chief of the Bureau of Automobile Repair (BAR). This bill would transfer the power of enforcement to CARB.

#### ACCC Opinion:

We are strongly opposed to this bill. CARB is too powerful now. This total concentration of power within one agency would create a judge, jury and executioner situation. We would prefer the checks and balances approach with BAR acting as administrator of inspection and maintenance of smog laws.

**<u>ACTION</u>**: Contact Assemblywoman Lieber and express your opinion on AB386.

<u>AB 184</u> – David Cogdill – R – Modesto Air quality, high polluter vehicle.

This bill would require BAR to develop a program where donated low emission vehicles would be given to owners of high polluter vehicles. The Carl Moyer Program, which is designed to provide incentives to farmers to replace high polluting diesel engines, would be tapped to provide money to the owners of these lower polluting vehicles, which would then be given to the owner of the gross polluter.

ACCC Action: Watch

**<u>SB953</u>** - Romero - Vehicle registration, amnesty, replica vehicles. Bill stalled in Senate—no action as of April 21, 2005.
