

# OCTOBER 15 VISIT TO BIG BREAK REGIONAL PARK

Our October event includes both a visit to Big Break in Oakley and a lunch at the Providence Bar & Eatery with a Car Show as an extra.

Dave DeCato has arranged with the restaurant to reserve some adjacent spaces in their parking lot for display of our cars around our lunchtime.

The park has a Visitor Center which is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesdays through Sundays.

We plan to meet at the Visitor Center at 10:30 a.m. and explore the shoreline and Park features until about 12:30 p.m. Then we will backtrack less than a mile to the shopping center at the intersection of Big Break Road and Main Street, where the Providence Bar & Eatery is located and have our lunch and hopefully a small car show.

TO GET THERE; From the south bay take I-680 north to State Route 4. Go east on SR 4 and exit SR 160 (toward Rio Vist, but don't cross the toll bridge) take the Main Street exit in Oakley. Continue about 1 mile and turn left on Big Break Road and watch for Park entrance on the right after about 1/4 mile.

From Livermore and Brentwood take Brentwood Blvd, which turns into Main Street and turn right on Big Break Rd,

#### **HISTORY**:

The entire Delta was dramatically transformed by the California Gold Rush, which accelerated the settlement of the Delta and the substantial land reclamation that changed the Delta area's environment. Unsuccessful Forty-Niners returned to the Delta from the Motherlode to farm the rich soils. Because of the annual flooding, they erected crude levees. In the 1870s, the clamshell dredge enabled farmers to erect more stable and extensive levees. By 1930, Delta reclamation was almost complete, with some 57 manmade islands encompassing over 550,000 acres. To this day, agriculture is the primary land use, particularly the production of dry-grains, asparagus and other specialty crops. The name "Big Break" comes from a 1928 break in the levee that separated an asparagus farm from the San Joaquin River and Dutch Slough.
